Positioning of toys on floor and table for PCFP



Toy Arrangement

Preferably with the child and parent out of the room, arrange the PCFP toys as show in the pictures, with the barn set, books and slinky on the table and the other toys in a ring on the floor. Leave a gap in the ring on the floor for the child such that the child is directly facing the camera and another gap in the ring of toys for the parent to sit, at approximately 90 degrees to the child such that the parent is not blocking the camera's view of the child.

Instructions to the Parent:

Give the parent the following directions preferably before entering the room. "We want to see how you and your child play. We have arranged some toys on the floor and at the table for you. Your child can play with all or just some of the toys. I'll show you where I'd like you to sit to start out and then I'll make an announcement for the camera, set the timer and be back in 15 minutes.

Make the standard announcement, as follows:

Date / ID# / Procedure name / Time period / State the parent's location (in the room) / Ask the videographer if the sound check is successful / When the videographer indicates the sound check is successful, start the timer, say "Start coding now", and leave the room.

Set the timer for 15 minutes
